THE ABOVE MENTIONED FORMAL INVITATION FOR BID IS HEREBY AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

QUESTIONS SUBMITTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH PRE-SUBMITTAL CONFERENCE AND RESTRICTIONS ON COMMUNICATION:

On July 19, 2022, the City of San Antonio hosted a Pre-Submittal Conference to provide information and clarification for the Formal Invitation for Bid (IFB) Annual Contract for HVAC Motors at Convention Center. Below is a list of questions that were asked at the pre-submittal conference and in accordance with Section 003 – INSTRUCTIONS FOR BIDDERS, Restrictions on Communication. The City’s official response to questions asked is as follows:

Question 1: What is the amperage for each motor?

Response: Baldor 7.5HP - 19.6/9.8, Baldor 10HP - 25/12.5, Baldor 15HP - 36.4/18.2, Baldor 20HP – 48/24, Baldor 25HP – 60/30; Baldor 30HP – 72/36; Baldor 40HP – 98/49

Question 2: If 1755 RPM motor is not available, is there another option that will work for these units?

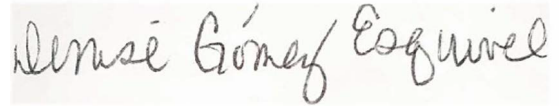
Response: We need to keep the RPM close to the 1700RPM but does not need to be 1700RPM exactly.

Question 3: Do all the units need to be delivered at the same time, on the same day?

Response: Deliver motors as ready and available, but no later than 4 weeks max lead time as per Section 004 – Specification/Scope of Services, Item 4.2 Lead Time. Do not hold them.

Question 4: Motors need to be held until requested or delivered when ready?

Response: Motors do not need to be held. Deliver as ready to ship, but no later than 4 weeks max lead time as per Section 004 – Specification/Scope of Services, Item 4.2 Lead time.
