Question 1:

The 010 formal invitation posted on the cosa website differs from what is posted on civcast. which one is correct?

On the 010 as posted on the cosa website

(<https://www.sa.gov/directory/departments/finance/about/divisions/procurement/bidding-contracting/opportunities> states, the total estimated value of this contract is \$10,000,000.00 for the initial and second term. The estimated contract amount for each contract term is \$3,000,000.00 per contract term. the civcast 010 states the estimated contract amount for each contract term is \$5,000,000.00 per contract term. Further, under the section payment and performance bond requirement it states, for this solicitation, the city requires the successful bidder to submit performance and payment bonds for the full contract amount for the initial term, estimated to be \$5,000,000.00 as identified in the construction estimated value section of this solicitation document. If the city opts to exercise the second contract term, the successful bidder must submit performance and payment bonds in the full contract amount of the second contract term estimated to be \$5,000,000.00 as identified in construction estimated value section of this solicitation document.

Within the specifications it states the contract shall be terminated two hundred and seventy (270) calendar days from the start of the contract.

The bid item for bonds (100.2), is ls (lump sum) with a quantity of 2? The door hangers (901.1) is ls for a quantity of 1? (I would think the unit should be ea (each) with a quantity of 2)

Clarify the intent of this contract. Is this a two-term contract estimated at \$ 5 million per term, or is this a two-term contract for \$10 million term? Are the 270 calendar days per term?

Answer:

010 form has been revised and uploaded into COSA website, this contract is a split term, \$10,000,000.00 total, \$5,000,000.00 per term.

The Unit is LS and bid quantity for the bond is 1.

The Unit is LS and bid quantity for the door hangers is 1.

The 270 calendar days are the total duration of the contract including both terms.
