**By virtue of this addendum, the specifications, requirements and amendments stated below become a permanent addition to the solicitation referenced above.**

### **THE ABOVE MENTIONED INVITATION FOR BID IS HEREBY AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:**

- 3. Modify: IFB Document Section 004 - Specifications/Scope of Services:**

#### **Section 4.1 is changed to read:**

- 4.1 SCOPE:** The City of San Antonio is soliciting bids to obtain an 18' shallow water, square bottom, boat for the San Antonio Park Police to patrol the San Antonio River. Supplied watercraft must meet United States Coast Guard (USCG), National Marine Manufacturers Association (NMMA), and American Boat and Yacht Council (ABYC) guidelines. The boat must be self-bailing. To ensure that the City of San Antonio receives a boat of proven performance, the supplied hull is required to be in current production. Awarded vendor shall be responsible to: 1) deliver complete boat to water; and 2) register vessel and outboard motor with the Texas Parks & Wildlife on behalf of the City of San Antonio. The 18' shallow water square bottom boat will be converted by a 3rd party to operate on

Compressed Natural Gas (CNG) post-delivery. Original warranty is agreed to remain intact less the fuel system. Bids shall include separate line-item pricing for optional equipment and alternative fuel system configuration. Award may be made on Base Bid only or Base Bid plus any selected options.

**4.3.2 MATERIAL:** Boat shall have a double plate bow nose. Boat shall be built of .100-inch aluminum with a .125-inch aluminum tread plate floor that is coated with a Line-X spray-in liner or equivalent. Spray liner shall fill floor where it meets wall seam to help prevent trash accumulation.

**Section 4.3.4 is changed to read:**

**4.3.4 OUTBOARD MOTOR:** The awarded vendor shall deliver the boat equipped with a Yamaha T9.9LPB outboard motor or approved equal and corresponding fuel tank. Supplied motor configuration shall be suitable for future conversion to CNG operation through a separate third-party contractor. Outboard motor shall be approximately 10 HP for use with a minimum 6-amp alternator.

**4.6.1 CNG-CONVERTED OUTBOARD MOTOR & FUEL TANK CONFIGURATION:** Additional cost to furnish the Base Bid Item #1 boat configuration modified to include a fully operational, turnkey CNG-converted Yamaha T9.9LPB outboard motor or approved equivalent with a minimum of 9.9 HP, including compatible CNG fuel tank and components required for operation. All other Base Bid Item #1 specifications shall remain unchanged.

Response: Yes. Bid pricing shall include the fuel tank and components necessary for normal operation of the supplied outboard motor configuration in accordance with the solicitation specifications.
