QUESTIONS SUBMITTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 003, INSTRUCTIONS FOR RESPONDENTS, PART A, RESTRICTIONS ON COMMUNICATION:

Question 1: Will there be any lead paint removal/replacement necessary?

Response: There will be no lead paint removal. All paint is waterborne.

Question 2: How will respondents price services for lead/non-lead paint?

Response: There is no lead paint.

Question 3: Regarding the Safety Traffic Plan, will traffic control services (cones/barricades) be provided by the contractor or Airport?

Response: Airport will provide all safety cones, barricades, etc.... as required.

Question 4: How many times per year will rubber/paint removal services be required?

Response: Rubber removal will be four (4) to five (5) times per year.

Question 5: Will a separate contract for paint replacement services be issued in conjunction with this contract?

Response: There will be no separate contract for paint replacement services. Painting is done internally by City staff.
