
1. Exhibit G – Insurance Requirements is revised.
 - a. Prime respondent must include language in the certificate of insurance “Description”: “Coverage pertains to multiple task orders to be issued throughout duration of the contract”.

QUESTIONS SUBMITTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION V, WORKSHOP:

On Wednesday, April 24, 2024, the City of San Antonio hosted a Workshop Conference to answer any questions bidders may have regarding 4Click Cost Data software, Job Order Contracting (JOC) Coefficients, Small Business Economic Development Advocacy (SBEDA), and Civcast reminders on submission deadlines for the Job Order Contracting (JOC) Program at San Antonio Airport System (DBE) Request for Competitive Sealed Proposals. Below is a list of questions that were asked at the workshop conference. The City's official response to questions asked is as follows:

Question 1: Is Builder Risk required for the entire contract or per task order?
Response: Firms are required to maintain a minimum of \$1,000,000 Builders Risk limit throughout duration of the contract. If a task order is higher than \$1,000,000, firms are required to increase the Builders Risk limit insurance limit to the task order value.
