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QUESTIONS SUBMITTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 003, PRE-SUBMITTAL CONFERENCE:

On February 16, 2023, the City of San Antonio hosted a WebEx Pre-Submittal Conference to provide information and clarification for the Formal Annual Contract for Police Pursuit Tires for Building and Equipment Services (BESD), Request for Offer. Below is a list of questions that were asked at the pre-submittal conference. The City's official response to questions asked is as follows:

Question 1: Since Firestone no longer offers a printed catalog and their government price list is on a single spreadsheet, can the "List Manufacturer's Price List Page Number" on the price schedule be omitted?

Response: The "List Manufacturer's Price List Page Number" has been removed from the price schedule.

Question 2: Are vendors only able to supply Goodyear and Firestone Police Pursuit Tires?

Response: Goodyear and Firestone tires are the approved tires for usage by the San Antonio Police Department.

Question 3: How often can vendors update the prices of the tires to match the Manufacturer Published Price List?

Response: The City will review all requests for price increase. Please refer to Section 005 – Catalog Discount Pricing. A written notice, of not less than 60 days, stipulating in detail the changes of a price list must be furnished by the vendor and approved by the City before revisions go into effect.

Question 4: Do vendors need to delete the reference part number listed in the price schedule?

Response: Bidders must complete Attachment A: Price Schedule – Revision 1, Dated February 23, 2023, to include the Bidder Part Number.
