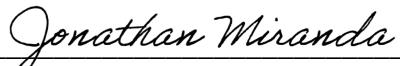
Question 1: The Statement of Qualifications in the RFP Package (Page 25-28) seems very construction focused. Please review and advise on the following: A.2.4 Superintendent – Is this to be the onsite supervisor? A.2.5 Project Coordinator – Please advise what role this is to be? A3 & A4 – Since all pricing is unit pricing and we are not sure what subs will be needed for this contract when the time comes are the Key Personnel/Organizational Charts and Resumes of Subs required? A5 Experience with Green Building and Sustainability Practices – Being that we aren't building anything is this supposed to be a description on how the disposed hazardous media is handled? B2 Construction Management Plan – Being this is an Environmental Remediation and Disposal Contract please advise on what we are to include for this section? B3 Commitment to Green Building and... – The second bullet point references a construction phase. Please advise if this section is needed.

Response: Since this question has multiple questions that were asked (above), below you will see each question answered.

- Question 1.1: “A.2.4 Superintendent – Is this to be the onsite supervisor?”
Response: Please see Section R. Manpower, a., on page 13 of the RFP.
- Question 1.2: “A.2.5 Project Coordinator – Please advise what role this is to be?”
Response: Coordinator of the project mentioned in the Project Sheet.
- Question 1.3: “A3 & A4 – Since all pricing is unit pricing and we are not sure what subs will be needed for this contract when the time comes are the Key Personnel/Organizational Charts and Resumes of Subs required?”
Response: Enter those that you feel are needed to complete the requirements as stated in the Statement of Qualifications.
- Question 1.4: “A5 Experience with Green Building and Sustainability Practices - Being that we aren't building anything is this supposed to be a description on how the disposed hazardous media is handled?”
Response: That is correct, this is to show how hazardous materials will be disposed of.
- Question 1.5: “B2 Construction Management Plan - Being this is an Environmental Remediation and Disposal Contract please advise on what we are to include for this section? B3 Commitment to Green Building and... - The second bullet point references a construction phase. Please advise if this section is needed.”
Response: Yes, it is needed to be included. This portion of the criteria is to provide commitment to green building as pertaining to the disposal of hazardous materials.
- Question 2: We are needing examples of Hazardous Waste as described in E.6 38-47. Different Hazardous Materials have different disposal rates.
Response: The Hazardous Waste items E.6 38-47, all them relate to contaminated soils, as the rest of the items in the section.
- Question 3: We are needing examples of what hazardous liquid are needed for pricing sheet E.7 53-57. Different hazardous liquids require different transportation requirements as well as different disposal rates.
Response: The Hazardous Waste items E.7 53-57, all them relate to contaminated water, as the rest of the items in the section.
- Question 4: We are needing examples of what hazardous liquid are needed for pricing sheet E.8 68-72. Different hazardous liquids require different drums, different transportation requirements as well as different disposal rates?
Response: All items alluring to liquid waste are related to contaminated water, and the ones for solid waste are for contaminated soils.
- Question 5: We are needing examples of what hazardous solids are needed for pricing sheet E.8 73-77. Different hazardous solids are sometimes required to go to different facilities and thus are different rates.
Response: All items alluring to hazardous solids are related to contaminated soils.
- Question 6: Please give more information (size, type, etc) on what kind of pump is desired for E.11 109
Response: The contractor must have a pump-to-pump contaminated water from a trench excavation, or from a frack tank.
- Question 7: Please give more information (size, rolls, etc.) on what unit is needed for Liner Material E.11 123.
Response: The liner materials require for this contract are utilized for placing contaminated, or lightly contaminated soils, and covering stockpiles, or to cover open trenches to prevent rain infiltration

- Question 8: Please verify what a "Sorter" is. E.11 154-157.
Response: A sorter is a type of equipment that would allow the Contractor to sort materials from different grain sizes. In some of our projects, rocks greater than 6 inches are not approved in properties where we relocate our City soils. The contractor should be able to sort the materials.
- Question 9: Please verify what kind (type, brand, specification, etc.) of Absorbent is desired for E.11 195
Response: Specifications were included with the TXDOT best Management Practices document.
