Question 1: Are vendors allowed to impound feral cats that it has conducted a spay/neuter surgery on if the vendor thinks they can find a home for the cat?

Response: Depending on their business practice, if a vendor decides to impound a feral cat, they will not be reimbursed for the surgery.

Question 2: What communities are these cats being pulled from?

Response: City of San Antonio Residents pull cats from all areas of town within the City of San Antonio. Any City of San Antonio Resident who traps a feral cat will qualify to get it spayed/neutered for free.
