QUESTIONS SUBMITTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 011, RESTRICTIONS ON COMMUNICATION:

Question 1: Does “members of the public” include the feral cat coalition and paid trappers?

Response: Yes, it can be Feral Cat Coalition and paid trappers so long as the services are available to the public. The trapper should not be charging the public for their services.

Question 2: How does the veterinarian establish which feral cats from the San Antonio area qualify?

Response: The person who brings the cat in for surgery must be a resident of the City of San Antonio.

Question 3: Is there a set of zip codes? The city limits? Or just “cat in trap submitted to clinic within city limits counts?”

Response: The cat must be trapped in city limits. There are no set zip codes. It will be the contractor's responsibility to verify that a resident's address is within the limits of the City of San Antonio.

Question 4: Are these services are provided at no cost to the trapper?

Response: There is no cost for anything in the scope of services. If the trapper elects to add any additional services outside the scope of services, they must pay for it. It will not be covered in the ACS contract.
