

AN ORDINANCE **97614**

ACCEPTING THE LOW BID AND AUTHORIZING \$73,198.65 FROM TEXAS COMMISSION ON ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY (TCEQ) GRANT FUNDS PAYABLE TO SAN ANTONIO CONSTRUCTORS, LTD., HEATH MANAGEMENT, L.L.C., GENERAL PARTNER, FOR CONSTRUCTION SERVICES IN CONNECTION WITH THE PAVEMENT REPLACEMENT PROJECT FOR THE HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE DROP-OFF CENTER, LOCATED AT 7030 CULEBRA IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 6; AUTHORIZING THE NEGOTIATION AND EXECUTION OF A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT; AUTHORIZING \$14,639.73 FOR MISCELLANEOUS CONSTRUCTION CONTINGENCY EXPENSES, FOR AN OVERALL TOTAL OF \$87,838.38; APPROPRIATING FUNDS; AND PROVIDING FOR PAYMENT.

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WHEREAS, bids were submitted in connection with the Pavement Replacement – Household Hazardous Waste Drop-off Center located at 7030 Culebra Road; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance accepts the low bid that was submitted by San Antonio Constructors, Ltd., Heath Management, L.L.C., General Partner in the amount of \$73,198.65 for pavement replacement at the Household Hazardous Waste facility, and \$14,639.73 for miscellaneous construction contingency expenses; and

WHEREAS, this facility provides San Antonio residents a location to dispose of hazardous household waste which cannot be disposed of through normal trash collection or at a city landfill; and

WHEREAS, the project consists of removing the existing asphalt from the Household Hazardous Waste facility, reshaping and compacting the sub-grade to improve drainage, installing concrete curbing adjacent to the oil containment tanks and drainage areas, and repaving with new asphalt; and

WHEREAS, this project is funded through a grant which was accepted on August 22, 2002 by Ordinance No. 96229 from the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality through the Alamo Area Council of Governments; and

WHEREAS, approval of this ordinance is a continuation of City policy to apply for and accept state and federal grants to support environmental protection; **NOW THEREFORE**,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The low bid of San Antonio Constructors, Ltd., Heath Management, L.L.C., General Partner, in the amount of \$73,198.65 in connection with the Pavement Replacement – Household Hazardous Waste Drop-off Center, is hereby accepted. All other bids will be considered rejected upon the execution of a contract by the successful bidder and the deposit of

all required bonds and insurance certificates or the expiration of sixty days from the effective date hereof, whichever occurs first. A copy of the proposal is attached hereto as **Attachment I**.

SECTION 2. The City Manager, an Assistant City Manager, or an Assistant to the City Manager, is hereby authorized to execute a standard form contract covering said project, a copy which is in substantially the same form as **Attachment II** is incorporated herein for all purposes.

SECTION 3. The following sums are hereby authorized for encumbrance in and payment from Project No. 26-008023.

\$73,198.65 payable to **San Antonio Constructors, Ltd., Heath Management, L.L.C., General Partner**, from Index No. 715543.

\$14,639.73 payable for misc. construction contingency from Index No. 715543.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocation to specific Index Codes and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.


SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take effect on the 25th day of May 2003.


