AN ORDINANCE

ACCEPTING THE LOW, RESPONSIVE BID SUBMITTED BY COMMERCIAL DATA SYSTEMS, UTILIZING THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF INFORMATION RESOURCES "GO DIRECT" PROGRAM TO PROVIDE THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY SERVICES DEPARTMENT WITH INPUT OUTPUT CARDS AND HOST BUS ADAPTERS FOR SUN F12K SERVERS FOR A TOTAL COST OF \$45,648.00.

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WHEREAS, a bid was submitted by Commercial Data Systems to provide the City of San Antonio ("City") Information Technology Services Department with input output ("I/O") cards and host bus adapters ("HBA") for Sun F12K servers for a total cost of \$45,648.00; and

WHEREAS, the I/O cards will allow multiple servers to function as one and be licensed as one allowing a more cost efficient Oracle license to be used; while the HBA's will be used to provide a connection between the servers to the data storage area and backup network allowing users access on the new configuration; and

WHEREAS, this purchase meets the requirements under the terms of the State of Texas Cooperative Purchasing Agreement adopted by the City of San Antonio by Resolution No. 91-39-53 on September 12, 1991; NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The bid of Commercial Data Systems to provide the City of San Antonio ("City") Information Technology Services Department with input output cards and host bus adapters for Sun F12K servers for a total cost of \$45,648.00 is hereby accepted, subject to and contingent upon the deposit of all required bonds, performance deposits and insurance certificates. A copy of the contract is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Attachment A.

SECTION 2. The amount of \$45,648.00 is authorized to be encumbered in Fund 74-001000, Information Services Fund, in General Ledger 5501000, entitled Capital Outlay <\$5,000, in Cost Center 090101001, and is authorized to be made payable to Commercial Data Systems when the purchase order is issued.

SECTION 3. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director, may subject to concurrence by the Interim City Manager or his designee, correct allocations to specific Cost Centers and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect April 17th, 2005.


