

AN ORDINANCE **100729**

**APPROVING THE PARADE PERMIT AND TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PORTIONS OF CERTAIN STREETS NEAR FREDERICKSBURG ROAD FOR THE HUMANE SOCIETY'S MUTT STRUTT TO BE HELD FROM 8:30 A.M. TO 10:30 A.M. ON SATURDAY, MAY 7, 2005.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The parade permit requested by the **Humane Society**, to hold the "Mutt Strutt" Run/Walk on Saturday, May 7, 2005, from 8:30 a.m. until 10:30 a.m., is hereby granted. The City finds that granting this request will promote the health, safety, and welfare of the participants and the public in the vicinity.

**SECTION 2.** In order to hold the "Mutt Strutt" Run/Walk on Saturday, May 7, 2005, beginning at 8:30 a.m. until 10:30 a.m., the temporary closure of certain streets listed in the route below to vehicular traffic is hereby authorized.

**Assembly Area:**

4804 Fredericksburg Road (Northwest corner of Fredericksburg and Woodlake)

**Run/Walk Route 1:**

Entering onto Woodlake,  
Woodlake from Fredericksburg to Northaven (1 lane-West curb),  
Northaven from Fredericksburg to Edgevale (Southbound lanes Only),  
Edgevale from Northaven to the crossover to Woodlake located one block South of Oakridge,  
Crossover from Edgevale to Woodlake (Southbound lanes only),  
Woodlake from the crossover to disband at 4804 Fredericksburg Road.

**Run/Walk Route 2:**

Entering on to Woodlake,  
Woodlake to Oakridge,  
Oakridge from Woodlake to Fawnridge,  
Fawnridge from Oakridge to Moss Oak,  
Moss Oak from Fawnridge to Edgevale,  
Edgevale from Moss Oak to Oakridge,  
Oakridge from Edgevale to Woodlake,  
Woodlake from Oakridge to disband at 4804 Fredericksburg Road (corner of Fredericksburg and Woddlake).

**SECTION 3.** Funds in the amount of \$25.00 are authorized to be deposited in Fund 11001000 entitled "General Fund", Internal Order Number 223000000082, entitled "TRFC ENG- DES/REV", General Ledger 4408100 entitled "Street-Barricade Fees" when received.

**SECTION 4.** The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific Cost Centers, WBS Elements, Internal Orders, General Ledger Accounts, and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance

**SECTION 5.** The **Humane Society** shall be responsible for the following: 1) fulfilling all insurance requirements, 2) paying the required street closure permit fee and any other fees and license charges, 3) posting signs, barricades and the use of any off duty or on-duty police officers, as may be required by the City of San Antonio's Public Works and/or Police Departments, 4) evidencing the street closure to provide for the safety of patrons and the rerouting of traffic, and 5) cleaning the area up after the event is held.

**SECTION 6.** The **Humane Society** shall assume all risks inherent in this event and shall indemnify and hold harmless the City of San Antonio from any and all costs, damages, injuries, or losses attendant to, or in any way growing out of this special use of the public street right-of-ways.

**SECTION 7.** This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage if passed by eight or more votes otherwise this ordinance shall become effective May 1, 2005.


