

AN ORDINANCE 100872

AUTHORIZING THE CO-ACCEPTANCE, WITH THE SAN ANTONIO WATER SYSTEM ("SAWS"), OF A GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,800,000.00 FROM THE U.S. ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT ADMINISTRATION (the "EDA") FOR THE INSTALLATION OF WATER AND SEWER INFRASTRUCTURE FOR THE TOYOTA MANUFACTURING FACILITY, ON-SITE SUPPLIER PARK ACTIVITIES, AND NEARBY COMMERCIAL DEVELOPMENT, FOR THE GRANT PERIOD OF JANUARY 1, 2005 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2009.

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WHEREAS, in its efforts to attract Toyota Manufacturing to San Antonio, the City structured an incentive package which included several improvement projects at the proposed Toyota site; and

WHEREAS, to offset costs, the U.S. Economic Development Administration (the "EDA") pledged to assist the City through grant funding for eligible projects; and

WHEREAS, a project that included the installation of infrastructure to convey sanitary sewer and/or possible industrial wastewater offsite from the Toyota Manufacturing facility, Toyota suppliers, and adjacent commercial development was identified by San Antonio Water System ("SAWS") ; and

WHEREAS, the project also includes the extension of potable water service to the utility yard area of the Toyota facility and the extension of recycled water service to the property line of the Toyota site; and

WHEREAS, in December 2004, the City and SAWS jointly submitted the project in an application for grant funding in the amount of \$1,800,000.00 to the EDA and has been awarded the funds based on the eligibility of the project; and

WHEREAS, the acceptance of the grant award assists the City in meeting contractual obligations, increases water and sewer capacity to permit operations by on-site suppliers to Toyota and nearby commercial development; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby approves the acceptance of a U.S. Economic Development Administration grant in the amount of \$1,800,000.00. Said grant is to be issued to and managed solely by San Antonio Water System.

SECTION 2. The Interim City Manager or a designated representative is authorized to execute a grant agreement as described above. The final Agreement shall be filed with this ordinance upon execution.


SECTION 5. This ordinance shall be effective on and after the tenth (10th) day after passage hereof.


