

AN ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION FOR STATE/FEDERAL ASSISTANCE PROVIDED THROUGH THE TEXAS STATE LIBRARY AND ARCHIVE COMMISSION IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$716,349.00 TO BE USED FOR THE PURPOSE OF PUBLIC LIBRARY DEVELOPMENT IN THE ALAMO AREA LIBRARY SYSTEM TO SUPPORT GRANT ADMINISTRATION, CONSULTING, NETWORKED RESOURCES, SERVICES TO DISADVANTAGED POPULATIONS, CONTINUING EDUCATION, COLLECTION DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMS AND THE PURCHASE OF LIBRARY MATERIALS.

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WHEREAS, the City of San Antonio is a Major Resource Center for the Alamo Area Library System, providing services to Bexar County and 20 other contiguous counties; and

WHEREAS, since 1972, the City has provided this service and has accepted federal grant funds through the Texas State Library and Archives Commission in support of this service; and

WHEREAS, the City must annually apply to receive the grant funds which make this service possible; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary for the City Council to authorize the submission of a grant application to the Texas State Library and Archives Commission; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

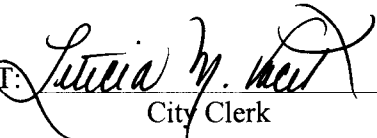
Section 1. The City Manager, or his designee, is hereby authorized to make application for state/federal assistance through the Texas State Library and Archives Commission in an amount not to exceed \$716,349.00 for use in the San Antonio Public Library's role as the Major Resource Center for the Alamo Area Library System, including for the purposes of supporting grant administration, consulting, networked resources, services to disadvantaged populations, continuing education, collection development programs and the purchase of library materials.

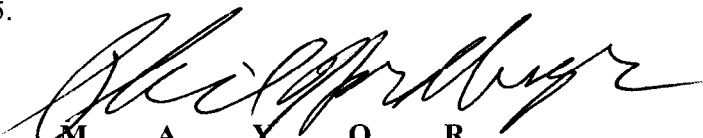
Section 2. Funding shall be accomplished in a subsequent ordinance, when funds are approved.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be effective on and after July 17, 2005.

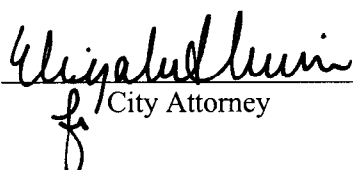
