

AN ORDINANCE **101334**

AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF A GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$750,000.00 FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES (DHHS) HEALTH RESOURCES & SERVICES ADMINISTRATION (HRSA) FOR THE SAN ANTONIO METROPOLITAN HEALTH DISTRICT TO CONTINUE THE ONGOING HEALTHY START INITIATIVE FOR A FIFTH YEAR TO REDUCE THE INCIDENCE OF INFANT MORTALITY AND LOW BIRTH WEIGHT IN TARGETED AREAS OF BEXAR COUNTY FOR THE PERIOD JUNE 1, 2005 THROUGH MAY 31, 2006; ADOPTING THE BUDGET; APPROVING THE PERSONNEL COMPLEMENT; AND AUTHORIZING PAYMENTS FOR CONTRACTUAL SERVICES.

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WHEREAS, the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District (SAMHD) delivers comprehensive public health services to protect the health of all residents within the jurisdiction of the SAMHD; and

WHEREAS, the SAMHD operates the Healthy Start Initiative, a project that provides extensive outreach, recruitment, case management and health education interventions to women and families in order to reduce the incidence of infant mortality and low birth weights in target communities; and

WHEREAS, a grant award in the amount of \$750,000.00 has now been offered from HRSA for the SAMHD to continue operation of the Healthy Start Initiative project for the fifth year during the period June 1, 2005 through May 31, 2006; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to authorize the acceptance of the grant award, adopt the project budget, approve the personnel complement, and authorize payments for contractual services; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager, or his designee, is authorized to accept a grant award of \$750,000.00 from the Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) Health Resources & Services Administration (HRSA) for the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District (SAMHD) to continue operation of the ongoing Healthy Start Initiative project for a fifth year to reduce the incidence of infant mortality and low birth weight during the budget period June 1, 2005 through May 31, 2006. The City Manager, or his designee, is authorized to execute such documents as the agency may require in awarding the grant. A copy of the DHHS HRSA Notice of Grant Award is set out in Attachment II and incorporated herein for all purposes.

SECTION 2. Fund No. 26022000, Funds Center 3606610000, has been designated for use in accounting for the fiscal transactions of said project. For the appropriation of funds for the Healthy

Start Initiative project, the Cost Center 3606610002 and Internal Order 136000000276 have been designated.

SECTION 3. The aggregate sum of \$750,000.00 is appropriated in the above-designated fund and the budget set out in Attachment I is approved and adopted for entry on the City books.

SECTION 4. Payments in an aggregate amount not to exceed \$45,958.00 are hereby authorized to be paid for rental of facilities in connection with the Healthy Start Initiative project. These payments will be made from Fund No. 26022000, Funds Center 3606610000, Cost Center 3606610002, Internal Order 136000000276, GL 5206010 on a monthly basis.

SECTION 5. Payments in an aggregate amount not to exceed \$23,284.00 are hereby authorized to be paid for the services of a HRSA required independent external program evaluator in connection with the Healthy Start Initiative project. These payments will be made from Fund No. 26022000, Funds Center 3606610000, Cost Center 3606610002, Internal Order 136000000276, GL 5201040, on a fee for service basis.

SECTION 6. The thirteen (13) personnel positions set out in Attachment I and incorporated herein are authorized for the activity shown thereon.

SECTION 7. The Director of Finance, may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocation to specific fund numbers, internal order numbers, and account numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this ordinance.

SECTION 8. Should the grant awarded be in an amount other than that budgeted for, or should the grant contain terms and conditions different than those currently existing, acceptance of the grant, budget and corresponding personnel complement will be subject to subsequent City Council ordinance.

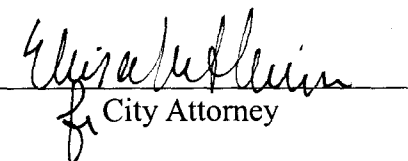
SECTION 9. This ordinance shall be effective on and after September 11, 2005.
