

AN ORDINANCE 2006-06-08-0692

AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 101477, PASSED ON SEPTEMBER 29, 2005 BY AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF AN ADDITIONAL \$89,500.00 IN REIMBURSEMENT GRANT FUNDS FROM THE TRANSPORTATION SECURITY ADMINISTRATION (TSA) FOR REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES RESULTING FROM INCREASED PARTICIPATION IN THE TSA EXPLOSIVES DETECTION CANINE TEAM PROGRAM AT SAN ANTONIO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT DURING FISCAL YEAR 2006; AUTHORIZING AN INCREASE IN THE TOTAL NUMBER OF CANINE TEAMS FROM FOUR TO FIVE, AND INCREASING THE AIRPORT POLICE OFFICER POSITION COMPLEMENT; APPROPRIATING FUNDS, AND AMENDING THE BUDGET.

WHEREAS, the Aviation and Transportation Security Act was established to improve airport security; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation Security Administration (TSA) offers reimbursement grant funding for enhanced security programs; and

WHEREAS, San Antonio International Airport desires to continue its participation in the TSA Explosives Detection Canine Team Program to respond to threats and suspected threats of explosives devices which affect public safety or air carrier operations; and

WHEREAS, on September 29, 2005, by Ordinance No. 101477 was passed, authorizing acceptance of a reimbursement grant from the TSA in the amount of \$160,500.00 for reimbursement of expenses incurred at the San Antonio International Airport in connection with its participation in the TSA Explosives Detection Canine Team Program during FY 2006; and

WHEREAS, the TSA offered additional reimbursement during this fiscal year in for expenses incurred in expanding the program to include an additional K-9 Explosives Detection Team; and

WHEREAS, in order to take advantage of these grant funds, it is necessary to authorize the acceptance of such additional funds from the TSA, authorize establishment of an additional K-9 Explosives Detection Team, increase the airport police officer position complement, amend the budget, and appropriate funds; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager, or her designee is authorized to accept and execute an Amendment of Ordinance No. 101477 passed on September 29, 2005 to authorize the acceptance of an additional \$89,500.00 in reimbursement grant funds from the Transportation Security Administration (TSA) for reimbursement of expenses resulting from increased participation in the TSA Explosives Detection Canine Team Program at the San Antonio International Airport

during fiscal year 2006, authorize an increase in the total number of canine teams from four to five, and increase the Airport Police officer position complement by one, appropriate funds, and amend the budget.

SECTION 2. Fund 26065000 entitled "Department of Homeland Security" and Internal Order 133000000035 entitled "FY06 Airport K9 Grant," is designated for use in the accounting for the fiscal transaction in the amending of the Funding Agreement with the TSA.

SECTION 3. The additional sum of \$89,500.00 is appropriated in the above designated fund and the revised budget set out in Attachment 1 is approved and adopted for entry on the City Books.


SECTION 4. Ordinance No. 101477, passed and approved on September 29, 2005 is amended to increase the number of canine teams at the San Antonio International Airport from four teams to five teams.

SECTION 5. Ordinance No. 101477, passed and approved on September 29, 2005 is amended to increase the complement in the Airport Operating Fund by one Airport Police Officer.

SECTION 6. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocation to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.


SECTION 7. This Ordinance shall be effective ten (10) days after its passage.
