SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

An ordinance renaming the 200 block of Paso Hondo to Robinson Place.

A request to change the street name of the 200 block of Paso Hondo to Robinson Place was submitted by Councilman John Sanders to honor David Robinson of the Spurs. Councilman Sanders feels it is only proper that the street name be changed to reflect Mr. Robinson's commitment and contribution to the education of the inner-city youth.

The Street Name Change Committee approved the request at a public hearing held on October 8, 2002. After receiving Unified Development Code approval, as required by ordinance, the Committee elected to forward the request to City Council.
