#### **SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS**

This ordinance accepts the low qualified bid and awards a 2000-2001 Facility Improvement and Maintenance Program (FIMP) funded construction contract in the amount of \$94,866.00 payable to 1904 Corporation, a non-MBE firm, and authorizes \$9,487.00 for miscellaneous construction contingency expenses and \$412.92 for Bid Advertising for an overall total of \$104,765.92 in connection with the Traffic Operations Building Roof Maintenance project located at 223 S. Cherry St. in Council District 2.

Staff recommends approval of this ordinance.

## **BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

The project provides for the reconstruction of the Traffic Operations Building roof, located at 223 S. Cherry St. which, has had severe roof leak problems for several years. The scope of services include the following:

- 1.) All existing roof panel to purlin fasteners will be removed and replaced with new oversized zinc aluminum fasteners with neoprene or EPDM sealing washers.
- 2.) All existing skylight panels will be removed and replaced with new preformed "R" panels matching the existing roof panels in color and configuration.
- 3.) Crickets, upslope from all roof penetrations, will be fabricated and installed to eliminate many of the sources of reoccurring leaks at penetration locations.
- 4.) New "R" panels will be installed along roof perimeters to cover the old existing internal gutters that have rusted and allow significant amounts of rainwater to enter the building.
- 5.) Old roof equipment curbs that are no longer in use for the operation of the building will be removed and replaced with new "R" panels.
- 6.) A new external gutter and downspout system will be fabricated and installed to control and direct roof drainage.

This project was advertised for construction bids in the Commercial Recorder, the San Antonio Informer, and La Prensa in July 2002. In addition, the bid announcement was made on CHIC-21, through the SBEDA office and Dodge Report. Plans were also available for review by potential bidders in the Public Works Office.

Bids for this project were opened on August 28, 2002 with four (4) bidders responding. Four bids were received, however, one bidder failed to include the required bid bond and that bid was considered non-responsive. A copy of a matrix reflecting the outcome of the bid process is attached.

The Economic Development Department has reviewed and approved the List of Subcontractors and the Good Faith Effort Plan submitted by 1904 Corporation.

The contract provides for 60 working days, or approximately three (3) months, to complete the project. 1904 Corporation does not currently have any contracts with the City of San Antonio.

## **POLICY ANALYSIS**

Approval of this ordinance will be a continuation of City Council policy to construct previously approved FIMP funded Capital Improvement Projects.

### **FINANCIAL IMPACT**

This is a one-time capital improvement expenditure. Funds in the amount of \$104,765.92 are available from 2000-2001 FIMP funds and authorized payable as follows:

\$ 412.92	payable for advertising expenses
