SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

This ordinance authorizes the City Manager, or her designated representative, to submit an \$80,000 grant application to the Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division (CJD). If awarded, the grant will fund the seventh year of the administrative and coordination efforts of the Crisis Assistance Team Administration (CATA) of the Victims Advocacy Section. This project will require an In-Kind Match of \$18,929 and a General Fund cash match of \$7,738.

Staff recommends approval.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The purpose of this grant project is to provide administrative and operational support to the Police Department's Crisis Assistance Teams. The Crisis Assistance Team Administration oversees the coordination of crisis intervention volunteers. This program is designed primarily as a collaborative effort in the community to address the issues of violence against women. A trained corps of community volunteers will provide crisis intervention for battered women and their children.

Two civilian positions, a Program Coordinator and an Assistant Program Coordinator, will continue to be funded through this grant to provide program support.

POLICY ANALYSIS

This Ordinance continues City Council's policy of seeking intergovernmental financial assistance for City crime prevention and enforcement programs. The program will enhance the City's efforts in dealing with domestic violence and victims of domestic violence.

FISCAL IMPACT

The Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division, will provide grant funds in the amount of \$80,000. Volunteer hours provided will be considered as an In-Kind Match of \$18,929 and the City will contribute a \$7,738 cash match.

COORDINATION

This ordinance request has been coordinated with Finance, City Attorney's Office and the Office of Management & Budget.
