SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

This ordinance ratifies services and appropriates funds in the total amount of \$1,918.00 for Invoice No. 31929 (\$1,612.00), Invoice No. 31930 (\$156.00), and Invoice No. 31991 (\$150.00) payable to Chemron Inc., a non-MBE firm, for environmental laboratory services in connection with the Flores from Durango to Franciscan project, an authorized 1996 Certificates of Obligation funded project, located in Council Districts 1, 3, and 5.

Staff recommends approval of this ordinance.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

This ordinance will provide compensation to Chemron, Inc., for environmental laboratory services related to the Flores from Durango to Franciscan project. Due to an area of concern identified within the project limits, the Environmental Services Department conducted soil sampling along the street right of way to determine if the subsurface soils have been impacted by potential contaminants. Soil samples were analyzed by Chemron under an existing Purchasing Contract. Results from this sampling event identified impacted soils within the project limits.

The Flores from Durango to Franciscan project provides for the reconstruction of base and pavement, four lanes with turn lanes at Durango and Alamo, with minimal curb and sidewalk replacement. This project does not include any replanking or upgrades across the track or in railroad right-of-way. The bridge over San Pedro Creek will be left in its existing condition.

POLICY ANALYSIS

Approval of this ordinance will be a continuation of City Council policy to construct previously approved 1996 Certificates of Obligation funded Capital Improvement Projects.

FISCAL IMPACT

This is a one-time capital improvement expenditure. The project will be funded in the amount of \$1,918.00 from 1996 Certificates of Obligation funds and authorized payable to Chemron, Inc.

COORDINATION

This request for ordinance has been coordinated with the Office of Management and Budget and the Finance Department.
