SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

Ordinance requests the street name change of a portion of Durango Blvd. E. (between IH 37 on the east and IH 35 to the west) to H.F. Garcia.

Staff recommends approval.

BACKGROUND

A request to change a portion of Durango Blvd. E. (between IH 37 on the east to IH 35 on the west) to HF Garcia was submitted by Councilman Bobby Perez (please see attached). The Street Name Change Committee approved the request at a public hearing held on May 1, 2002. After receiving Unified Development Code approval, as required by ordinance, the Committee elected to forward the request to City Council.

POLICY ANALYSIS

The U.S. Postal Service and City Public Service voiced no objections to the name change.

FISCAL IMPACT

The \$250.00 application processing fee and \$2,875.32 for the replacement of street signs has been paid. The applicants will raise funds for the remaining costs for replacement of Highway signage, estimated at approximately \$100,000.
