SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

This ordinance reallocates \$795,016 included in the FY 2003 Adopted Budget for the provision of services to six proposed annexation areas that were subsequently removed from the Annexation Plan as a result of November 21, 2002 Council action. Specifically, the ordinance increases the Brooks City-Base Fund professional services budget by \$135,000 for 24-hour security operations at the Brooks City-Base facility; adds one Economic Development Manager position to the Economic Development Department at a cost of \$65,000; increases Fire Department General Fund Budget by \$471,247 and Emergency Medical Services Fund Budget by \$123,769; increases the General Fund transfer to the Brooks City-Base Fund by \$135,000; increases the General Fund transfer to the Emergency Medical Services Fund by \$123,769 and amends several departmental budgets and staffing as outlined in Attachment "A".

Staff recommends approval of this ordinance.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The adoption of the FY 2003 Budget anticipated the possibility that the City Council would modify the 2002 Annexation Plan. On November 21, 2002, City Council elected to amend/remove the six areas listed below from the Annexation Plan. This action provides \$795,016 in additional savings in the FY 2003 General Fund operating budget, making the funds available for reprogramming.

- ◆ Galm Road/1604 (amended)
- ♦ Cielo Vista

- ♦ Lumbermen's Tract
- ♦ Stanton Run
- ♦ Helotes Park Terrace
- ♦ Kyle Seale/1604

With the removal of these areas from the Annexation Plan, the ordinance applies the \$795,016 in resources to the programs as listed below. The implementation of these changes requires action by ordinance:

- ⇒ Addition of \$135,000 to Brooks City-Base to fully fund 24-hour security operations at the facility
- ⇒ Addition of one Economic Development Manager to the Economic Development Department (at an added cost of \$65,000) that would permit the restoration of one Economic Development Manager eliminated by the Adopted FY 2003 Budget.
- ⇒ Addition of six positions and \$595,016 to the Fire Department Budget
 - General Fund
 - Restore two Lieutenant positions eliminated in the FY 2003 Adopted Budget (at an added cost of \$142,578).
 - Restore one Fire Apparatus Operator position eliminated in the FY 2003 Adopted Budget (at an added cost of \$61,719). This position will be assigned to the Public Education Program to make presentations to various businesses and organization throughout the community.
 - Restore two Personnel Investigator positions eliminated in the FY 2003 Adopted Budget (at an added cost of \$50,052). These positions will be assigned to the Arson Investigation Unit.
 - Restore \$134,967 in general overtime and overtime for the Safehouse Program which was reduced in the FY 2003 Adopted Budget.
 - Add one Captain position to be assigned to the Service Truck being added to Station # 46 as a part of the 1997 Annexation of Stone Oak (at an added cost of \$81,931).
 - Emergency Medical Services Fund
 - Restore \$123,769 in Overtime for Training, District Officer coverage, and Captain coverage which was reduced in the FY 2003 Adopted Budget.

POLICY ANALYSIS

The ordinance is consistent with direction from City Council on November 21, 2002.

FISCAL IMPACT

The ordinance reallocates \$795,016 in already budgeted funds. Attachment "A" shows the details of the proposed budget amendments, reflecting the net change for annexation amendments and reallocation of funding and staffing.

COORDINATION

This ordinance has been coordinated with all affected departments providing annexation-related services as well as specifically the Fire Department, the Economic Development Department, Brooks City-Base Office and the City Attorney's Office.
