SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

This ordinance authorizes the City Manager to accept a cash grant award of \$25,000.00, execute an agreement with the Texas Department of Health (TDH) to renew the ongoing Childhood Lead Poisoning Prevention Program at the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District (SAMHD) for the period July 1, 2002 through June 30, 2003, revise the budget of the Public Health State Support Project 2002/2003, and approve the personnel complement.

Staff recommends approval.

BACKGROUND

TDH provides annual financial assistance to the City to support public health activities provided by the SAMHD. For the current grant cycle, much of this funding is being provided through a contract approved by City Council on January 24, 2002. This contract, including nine (9) contract change notices that were approved in previous ordinances, currently provides \$5,200,932.00 in cash support, \$54,312.00 in-kind support, and \$5,218,981.00 in contract (feefor-service) support for various SAMHD activities. TDH has now offered another contract change notice that will furnish \$25,000.00 in cash to renew the ongoing Childhood Lead Poisoning Prevention Program. This additional funding brings the total cash support under this contract to \$5,225,932.00.

Under the Childhood Lead Poisoning Prevention Program, SAMHD staff organizes public awareness health fairs, conducts seminars for physician staffs and provides free blood lead screening to children in high-risk areas of San Antonio. The funding provided by TDH supports a part-time Office Assistant whose duties include clerical responsibilities such as preparing correspondence, data entry, answering telephones and filing documents. This person also assists in coordinating follow up screening activities on those children with elevated blood lead levels and helps in maintaining the database developed for this purpose.

POLICY ANALYSIS

Acceptance of this grant from TDH will continue the long-standing practice of utilizing Federal and State aid to support the local public health programs of the City.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The total TDH cash support under this current contract will increase by \$25,000.00 to \$5,225,932.00. Acceptance of this contract amendment will place no demand on the City General Fund.

COORDINATION

The Finance Department has approved the proposed project budget.

SUPPLEMENTARY COMMENTS

Provisions of the Ethics Ordinance do not apply.
