SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

This Ordinance approves five new appointments and three reappointments to the Alamo Workforce Development Board. Appointed in the business category were: Dr. Carlos Campos, Ramon Chapa Sr., Phyllis Gallay, and Antonio Perales. Dr. Cecilia Gonzales was appointed to fill the Adult Basic and/or Continuing Education slot. Elaine Mendoza, Donald Sikes and Terry Smith were all reappointments.

Staff recommends approval of this ordinance.

BACKGROUND

Recommendations for appointments to the Alamo Workforce Development Board (AWDB) are made by the Committee of Six, a representative committee made up of two elected officials each from the City, Bexar County and the remaining rural counties in the Alamo Workforce Development Area (AWDA). Submission of the nominee slate must be approved by all of the Principals in the local workforce area; these consist of the City Council, Bexar County Commissioner's Court, and the Area Rural Judges. The Rural Area Judges have approved the slate. Action is scheduled by Commissioner's Court for January 14, 2003.

POLICY ANALYSIS

This ordinance is a continuation of current City policy authorizing the City Council to review and approve appointments to the AWDB through the Interlocal Agreement between the Chief Elected Officials and the Alamo Workforce Development Inc.
