SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

This ordinance authorizes the City Manager to enter into an agreement with the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) for the furnishing and installation of traffic signal equipment by City of San Antonio forces on Lockhill-Selma Road at George Road in conjunction with Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) Project STP 98(271)MM.

Staff recommends approval of this ordinance.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The Metropolitan Planning Organization is sponsoring a project for improvements related to Lockhill-Selma Road. Included in the project is the reconstruction of one existing traffic signal at: George Road.

The City will be responsible for acquisition of traffic signal equipment and the Texas Department of Transportation will reimburse the City for furnishing and installing the equipment at the above intersection under this agreement. TxDOT standard specifications for traffic signal equipment are incompatible with the City of San Antonio's standard specifications. The City, therefore, takes responsibility for acquisition of traffic signal equipment on TxDOT designed projects in order to ensure that the installation will be compatible with existing City-maintained traffic signal infrastructure.

This project is scheduled for completion by TxDOT in February 2003.

POLICY ANALYSIS

Approval of this ordinance will be a continuation of Council policy to upgrade traffic signals as funds become available.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The agreement specifies that the Texas Department of Transportation will reimburse the City of San Antonio an amount not to exceed \$12,594.00 for the expenses incurred in providing and installing equipment to reconstruct the aforementioned signals.

COORDINATION

This request for Ordinance has been coordinated with the Office of Management and Budget and the Finance Department.
