SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

This ordinance authorizes the temporary closure of San Saba Street for thirteen special events in Market Square for the year 2003.

Staff recommends approval of this ordinance.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

For many years, staff has requested authorization for the temporary closure of San Saba Street, between West Commerce and Dolorosa Streets, for the purpose of pedestrian safety and for the assembly of entertainment stages for scheduled Market Square special events. Scheduled events for 2003 are as follows:

> March 15th through March 16th, 2003 Spring Fest April 4th through April 6th, 2003 Tejano Awards Fanfare

Passion Play April 18, 2003

May 2nd through May 4th, 2003 Cinco de Mayo May 24th through May 26th, 2003 Return of the Chili Queens June 21st through June 22nd, 2003 Summerfest

July 4th through July 6th, 2003 Freedom Fest July 19th through July 20th, 2003 S.A. Cojunto Shootout

July 25th, 2003 ADA Walk

August 2nd through August 3rd, 2003 Feria de Agosto El Mercado 27th Birthday/ August 30th through September 1st, 2003

Labor Day Fest September 12th through September 14th, 2003 Fiestas Patrias November 28th through November 30th, 2003 Feria de Santa Cecilia

POLICY ANALYSIS

This action is consistent with City policy in authorizing the temporary closure of public streets for public safety purposes.

FISCAL IMPACT

The event sponsors are required to pay all costs for barricades directly to the vendor that sets up and removes the equipment. Also, the established rental fee for San Saba Street closing of \$750.00 per day is paid to the City's General Fund. Estimated total revenue will be approximately \$18,000.00. This action will place no additional demands on the General Fund.

COORDINATION

The street closures for these Market Square Special Events in 2003 have been coordinated with the Department of Public Works and the Police Department's Traffic Division.

SUPPLEMENTARY COMMENTS

This ordinance does not require the completion of any disclosures under the City's Ethics Ordinance.
