SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATION

This Ordinance shall be placed on the City Council agenda of March 6, 2003 to accept the resignation of part-time Municipal Court Judge David J. Rodriguez who submitted his letter of resignation effective March 1, 2003 (Letter attached), and declare a vacancy. Staff recommends approval of this Ordinance.


BACKGROUND

Judge David J. Rodriguez was originally appointed as part-time Municipal Court Judge on January 6, 2000 and reappointed on August 16, 2001 for a term to expire on August 31, 2003. Due to the need to replace Judge Rodriguez as quickly as possible in order to maintain the efficient operation of the Municipal Court, an emergency will be declared to have the ordinance to take effect immediately upon the affirmative vote of eight (8) members of the City Council. Staff shall be directed to take all steps necessary to fill this vacancy at the earliest possible date.

The term of appointee to replace Mr. Rodriguez shall be for the unexpired term which runs through August 31, 2003.
