SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

This ordinance authorizes the City Manager to accept and execute a cash grant contract in an amount not to exceed \$64,194.00 from the U.S. Conference of Mayors Research and Education Foundation (COMREF) to support the Brotha to Brotha HIV Intervention Project of the ongoing HIV/AIDS Program of the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District (SAMHD) for the period March 1, 2003 through February 29, 2004. This ordinance also establishes a fund, adopts a budget, approves a personnel complement, approves the execution of a subcontract with BEAT-AIDS, Inc., and authorizes payments for contractual services.

Staff recommends approval.

BACKGROUND

The United States Conference of Mayors (USCM) in cooperation with the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, National Center for HIV, STD, and TB Prevention, issued a Request for Proposals (RFP) for the HIV/AIDS Prevention Grants Program to strengthen local capacities to carry out effective HIV/AIDS prevention activities. SAMHD's proposal, chosen on merit, addressed the USCM Track Two funding priority of Implementation of HIV/AIDS Prevention Services Targeting Gay/Bisexual Men of Color (GBMC). Because the SAMHD demonstrated strong community ties with specific experience in serving the target group, the USCM made the grant to complement efforts already under way by the SAMHD. This grant will be used to conduct AIDS intervention workshops with course facilitators. Review sessions will be used to critically assess the success of the program. For many years the SAMHD has contracted with BEAT-AIDS, Inc. which works to prevent AIDS in the African-American community. BEAT-AIDS, Inc. will assist in the recruiting effort and administering incentives.

The personnel complement consists of two (2) part time positions.

POLICY ANALYSIS

Acceptance of this grant from TDH will continue the long-standing practice of utilizing Federal and State and private foundation aid to support the local public health programs of the City.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

This COMREF contract provides \$64,194.00 in cash to support the Brotha to Brotha HIV Intervention Project of the ongoing HIV/AIDS Program of the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District (SAMHD). Acceptance of this contract award will place no demands on the City General Fund.

COORDINATION

The City Attorney's Office and the Office of Management and Budget, Risk Management Division have reviewed the contract with COMREF. The Finance Department has approved the proposed project budget.

SUPPLEMENTARY COMMENTS

Provisions of the Ethics Ordinance do not apply.
