SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

This ordinance ratifies and approves a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funded Field Alteration No. 4 in the amount of \$40,000.00 payable to R.L. Jones, L.P., a non-MBE firm, for construction expenses in connection with the Alice Fay Area Streets (39th Street, #58M, Phase III) project located in Council District 6.

Staff recommends approval of this ordinance.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

This Field Alteration No. 4 provides for additional driveway penetrations required due to street cutting. When this street was reconstructed, it was lowered to provide better drainage for the area. This caused the new driveway approaches to be too steep when connected at the property line. Therefore, it became necessary for the concrete to penetrate into private property to achieve the required slope grade of 14%. This will prevent tailpipes and bumpers from dragging on the new street, but it also increased the amount of concrete required. Because the consulting engineer did not anticipate these increases, this field alteration is necessary to cover the expense of the additional driveway work.

This project provides for the reconstruction for the following streets to a 30-foot typical width: Buena Vista and Fridell from Acme Road to Capehart; Enid and Pharis from Acme to Luxemburg and Luxemburg from Enid to Pharis. Parkway Improvements such as new curbs, driveway approaches, sidewalks, necessary drainage, and utility improvements are also included. This project was completed in January 2003.

This construction contract was approved by City Council, Ordinance No. 95401, dated March 7, 2002 and initially authorized \$1,024,673.25 for construction services related to this project. Previously approved Field Alterations totaling \$25,660.96 increased the total contract award to

\$1,050,334.21. This Council action increases the total amount authorized for this construction contract to \$1,090,334.21.

POLICY ANALYSIS

Approval of this ordinance will be a continuation of City Council policy to complete previously approved CDBG funded Capital Improvement Projects.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

This is a one-time capital improvement expenditure within budget and not included in the Capital Improvement Program. Funds in the amount of \$40,000.00 are available from CDBG funds and authorized payable to R.L. Jones L.P. This item represents a portion of a total estimated City project cost of \$1,059,339.00.

COORDINATION

This request for Ordinance has been coordinated with the Office of Management and Budget and the Finance Department.

SUPPLEMENTARY COMMENTS

This contract was developed utilizing the formal competitive bid process; therefore, a Discretionary Contracts Disclosure Form is not required.

When streets are reconstructed they are usually lowered to provide better drainage for the area. This causes the new driveway approach to be too steep if it's connected at the property line. It then becomes necessary for the concrete to penetrate into private property so a sloped grade of 14% can be provided. This will prevent tailpipes and bumpers from dragging on the new street but it also increases the amount of concrete required. Because the consulting engineer did not anticipate these increases the original quantity had to be exceeded to cover the expense of the additional driveway work.
