Subject: "B" Session Presentation – Proposed Emergency Operations Center

SUMMARY:

This "B" Session item will include a City staff presentation on the new Emergency Operations Center (EOC) that has been proposed as a 2003 General Obligation Bond Project. This briefing will include the need for a new EOC, its potential functions, desirable location attributes, design alternatives and costs. Discussion of the existing EOC and its limitations will also be provided.

Four EOC design alternatives will be described:


Option A – New EOC incorporating a new 311 Call Center

Option B – New EOC without a new 311 Call Center

Option C – New EOC incorporating a new 311 Call Center and 100% redundant Public Safety Answering Point (PSAP)


Option D – New EOC incorporating a new 311 call center and 25% redundant PSAP
