### **SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATION**

This ordinance appropriates the sum of \$813,368.00 for fee simple title and/or easement interest to certain privately owned real property and other miscellaneous expenses associated with the Loop 410 at Nacogdoches Drainage Improvement project, a 2001 Certificates of Obligation project located in Council Districts 9 and 10. This ordinance authorizes city staff to acquire these properties at fair market value by negotiation or condemnation, if necessary.

Staff recommends the approval of this ordinance.

#### **BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

There are nine parcels to acquire in this project. This project is currently scheduled to be advertised in September 2004 by the Texas Department of Transportation, start construction in December 2004, and completed by December 2006. The City of San Antonio is providing all right of way and 80% of the construction costs and the Texas Department of Transportation is providing the remaining 20%. The scope of this project includes widening and deepening the existing drainage easement along the subject site from IH 410 just west of Nacogdoches to Haskins.

# **POLICY ANALYSIS:**

This ordinance will streamline the process for acquiring right of way for this project and the payment of the miscellaneous expenses associated with this project.

# **FISCAL IMPACT**

This is a one-time capital improvement expenditure within budget and included in the FY03-08 Capital Improvement Program Budget. Funds in the amount of \$813,368.00 are available from 2001 Certificates of Obligation. This item represents a portion of a total estimated project cost of \$4,411,000.00.

# **COORDINATION**

This ordinance was coordinated with the City Attorney's Office, the Office of Management and Budget, the Finance Department, and the Texas Department of Transportation.
