ORDINANCE ACCEPTING AN INVESTIGATOR AGREEMENT WITH

GLAXOSMITHKLINE PHARMACEUTICALS

SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

This ordinance authorizes the City Manager to accept and execute an Investigator Agreement with GlaxoSmithKline Pharmaceuticals (GSK) for the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District (SAMHD) to participate in a follow-on clinical research study of a combined immunization for the prevention of hepatitis A and hepatitis B in healthy adults 18 years of age or older. GSK will provide SAMHD up to \$64,350.00 in cash to conduct the study during the period March 28, 2003 through March 27, 2005.

Staff recommends approval.

BACKGROUND

Between October 1, 1999 and December 30, 2000, SAMHD participated in a clinical trial study that administered the HAVRIX® vaccine to children to protect against hepatitis A. Now GSK has developed a combined hepatitis A and hepatitis B vaccine, TWINRIX®, which will be given on an accelerated schedule compared to separate vaccinations for hepatitis A and hepatitis B. The hepatitis A vaccine requires two injections in six months and the hepatitis B vaccine requires three injections in four months, for a total of five injections. By using the TWINRIX® vaccine the number of injections is reduced from five to three for the same protection.

The standard primary course of vaccination consists of three doses, the first dose administered at the elected date, the second dose one month later and the third dose six months after the first dose. In this study, SAMHD will enroll thirty (30) healthy adults 18 years of age or older. This study will consist of three (3) visits to receive the doses and five (5) follow-up monitor visits. Adults enrolled in this study will receive all vaccines free of charge and will be reimbursed \$25.00 upon completion of each visit. This compensation is for travel expenses, childcare and/or leave from work.

The personnel complement for this project is one (1) part-time Health Program Supervisor and one (1) part-time Public Health Nurse. Both positions are being utilized with concurrent GSK projects.

POLICY ANALYSIS

Acceptance of this agreement from GlaxoSmithKline Pharmaceuticals will continue the long-standing practice of utilizing Federal, State and other aid that is available to support the local public health programs of the City.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The total project budget for this agreement is \$64,350.00. This project will place no demands on the City General Fund.

COORDINATION

The City Attorney's Office and the Office of Management and Budget, Risk Management Division, have reviewed and approved the agreement with GSK. The Finance Department has approved the proposed project budget.

SUPPLEMENTARY COMMENTS

Provisions of the Ethics Ordinance do not apply.
