<u>Joe Rodriguez</u>, representing the owner, stated the purpose of this request is to allow openair flea market to be operated in conjunction with an existing football field and concession stand. He stated the flea market would be adjacent to the football field.

Staff stated there were 12 notices mailed out to the surrounding property owners, 0 returned in opposition and 3 returned in favor and no response from Pecan Valley Neighborhood Association and have received 5 letters in support of the request.

Everyone present, for and against having been heard and the results of the written notices having been received, the Chairman declared the public hearing closed.
