#### Staff Recommendation:

Approval. The subject property is currently a Single-Family residential structure. The property abutts "O-2" zoning and use to the Northeast. There is also "O-2" and Commercial zoning across Nacogdoches Road to the Northwest and North of subject property respectively. The following conditions are required in a residential zoning district unless approved otherwise by City Council:

- 1.) There shall be no exterior display or sign with the exception that a nameplate, not exceeding three (3) square feet in area, may be permitted when attached to the front of the main structure.
- 2.) No construction features shall be permitted which would place the structure out of character with the surrounding neighborhood. 3.) Business or office hours of operation shall not be permitted before 7:00 a.m. or after 6:00 p.m. Staff recommends additional conditions:
- 1.) A six feet wooden privacy fence will be erected along the entire length of the rear yard property line of subject property.
- 2.) Predicated on the City Traffic Department approval, access to and egress from the property in question will be from Nacogdoches Road as opposed to using the Oak Ledge entrance, with the exception of the property owners and employees who may use the Oak Ledge entrance.
- 3.) No paving will be done on subject property that will adversley affect drainage of adjoining properties.
