

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING RE-AUTHORIZATION OF FUNDS FROM THE 2000 HOUSING OPPORTUNITIES FOR PERSONS WITH AIDS (HOPWA) GRANT AND RE-AUTHORIZATION AND RE-PROGRAMMING OF FUNDS

SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

This ordinance approves the re-authorization of funds from the 2000 Housing Opportunities for persons with AIDS (HOPWA) grant to San Antonio Alternative Housing Corporation (SAAHC), in the amount of \$245,648.00. This ordinance also approves reallocation and reprogramming from the 2001 HOPWA grant in the amount of \$250,132.00. It reallocates \$185,244.09 to the House of Hope and reprograms \$60,000,00 to the SAAHC and \$4,887.91 to the San Antonio AIDS Foundation (SAAF).

Staff recommends approval of this ordinance.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Ordinance #93959 passed and approved on May 17, 2001, authorized an allocation of \$272,500 to the House of Hope from the 2001 HOPWA. The House of Hope expended \$22,368 in support services. House of Hope had planned to purchase two houses using 2001 HOPWA Funds. The contract for this project expired before House of Hope was able to purchase the houses due to a lengthy environmental review requested by HUD. Therefore, \$185,244.09 from the original award to House of Hope needs to be re-allocated to the House of Hope for the acquisition of the two houses. Funds in the amount of \$64,887.91 will not be spent and need to be re-programmed for other HOPWA approved activities.

San Antonio Alternative Housing Corp.

Funds in the amount of \$245,648.00 need to be re-allocated to the SAAHC for the construction of a six unit complex for persons living with HIV/AIDS because the original contract expired prior to the commencement of the project. The project was delayed because SAAHC needed additional funds before it could begin construction due to design enhancements resulting from community requests that the project contain a storefront. Zoning change to this property was approved by City Council on January 25, 2001 to allow for the storefront.

The reprogramming of \$60,000, from the 2001 HOPWA award, to the San Antonio Alternative Housing Corp. (SAAHC) will supplement previous HOPWA awards for project enhancements. The re-authorization and reprogramming will allow SAAHC to begin the construction project. Below is a table that identifies funding for this project:

San Antonio AIDS Foundation

The San Antonio AIDS Foundation (SAAF) will utilize the reallocation of \$4,887.91 from the 2001 HOPWA grant for Tenant Based Rental Assistance (TBRA). TBRA provides four to 12 months of rent subsidy to persons with HIV/AIDS.

Currently, the San Antonio AIDS Foundation has a total of 133 households enrolled in the TBRA program. With this reprogramming, SAAF proposes to serve an additional 16 households.

POLICY ANALYSIS

This ordinance will continue existing City policy to provide needed services to low-income residents with HIV/AIDS in the San Antonio Eligible Metropolitan Statistical Area. This includes the counties of Bexar, Comal, Guadalupe and Wilson.

Award of HOPWA re-programming funds and the resulting contract amendments do not require an additional procurement process since both projects were previously awarded through Request for Proposals issued by the Department of Community Initiatives under HOPWA 2000 and 2001.

In accordance with federal regulations a public hearing will be held prior to Council action.

FISCAL IMPACT

This ordinance re-allocates \$185,244.09 to the House of Hope and re-programs \$60,000 to SAAHC and \$4,887.91 to the San Antonio AIDS Foundation from the 2001 HOWPA grant. It also authorizes the re-allocation of \$245,648 to San Antonio Alternative Housing from the 2000 HOPWA grant. There is no General Fund commitment.

COORDINATION

Coordination has occurred with the City Attorney's Office, the Department of Housing & Community Development, Finance Department, Department of Asset Management, and Office of Management & Budget.
