Development Project for Future Phase II Project Funding

SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

This ordinance appropriates \$628,000.00 in 1999 Park Bond Funds into the Crownridge Canyon Nature Area Development Project, located in City Council District 8, for future Phase II Project funding.

Staff recommends approval of this ordinance.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Ordinance 94742, Ordinance 96197 and Ordinance 97357 established a project budget for the Crownridge Canyon Nature Area Development Project and approved consultant services. A karst assessment and a habitat assessment were performed on the property and a landscape design firm, Bender Wells Clark Design, has been hired to prepare a design for development of this nature park. The Proposition 3 Edwards Aquifer Project Fund provided funding for all of these services.

The 1999 Park Bond Issue approved funds for park land acquisition and development in City Council District 8. Specifically, the Issue approved this funding for Friedrich Park and other areas east of Babcock and north of Loop 1604. Through the proposed ordinance, funding of \$628,000.00 will be appropriated into the Crownridge Canyon Nature Area project budget for future development of the nature park. The added funds will provide for additional nature and ADA trails, pedestrian bridges, infrastructure and appropriate park amenities.

POLICY ANALYSIS

This action is consistent with the approval of the City voters of 1999 Park GO Bonds for the acquisition and development of park land in City Council District 8.

FISCAL IMPACT

Funding of \$928,000.00 was approved in the 1999 Park Bond Issue for land acquisition and development in City Council District 8 for Friedrich Park and other areas east of Babcock and north of Loop 1604. This ordinance will appropriate the amount of \$628,000.00 into Phase II Project Funds. This action will place no demands on the City's General Fund.

COORDINATION

This acquisition was coordinated through the City Council District 8 office, the Office of Management and Budget and Finance Department.


