SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

This ordinance accepts the low qualified responsive bid and awards a construction contract in the amount of \$737,217.90 payable to R. L. Jones, LP., a non-MBE firm, and authorizes \$57,664.44 for construction contingency expenses, for an overall total of \$794,882.34 in connection with the Hoover Street from Nogalitos to Charlotte project, an authorized 1999 General Obligation Drainage Improvement Bond project, located in Council District 5. Of the \$794,882.34, \$634,308.84 will be funded from General Obligations of the City, and \$160,573.50 will be funded by San Antonio Water System (SAWS) for sewer and water work.

Staff recommends approval of this ordinance.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The Hoover Street from Nogalitos to Charlotte project provides for a typical 30-foot wide, 2-lane street section with necessary drainage. This project will reconstruct Hoover from Charlotte to Nogalitos and includes 6-foot sidewalks along the southside at the school and 4-foot sidewalks along the northside, curbs, and driveway approaches. The project schedule was adjusted to coincide with the school year. This project is scheduled to begin construction July 2003, and be completed by February 2004.

This project was advertised for construction bids in the Commercial Recorder, the San Antonio Informer, and La Prensa in March 2003. In addition, the bid announcement was made on TVSA, through the SBEDA office and Dodge Report. Plans were also available for review by potential bidders in the Public Works Office.

Bids for this project were opened on April 30, 2003 with seven (7) bidders responding. A matrix reflecting the outcome of the bid process is attached.

The Economic Development Department has reviewed and approved the List of Subcontractors and the Good Faith Effort Plan submitted by R. L. Jones, LP. The contractor has committed to subcontract \$153,000.00 (21%) of their contract to MBE firms. The contract provides for 130 working days or approximately seven (7) months to complete the project. R. L. Jones, LP. currently has four (4) construction contracts with the City of San Antonio in the total amount of \$2,797,081.00. A list of these projects is attached.

POLICY ANALYSIS

Approval of this ordinance will be a continuation of City Council policy to complete previously approved 1999 General Obligation Drainage Improvement Bond funded Capital Improvement Projects.

FISCAL IMPACT

This is a one-time capital improvement expenditure within budget and included in the FY 03-08 Capital Improvement Program Budget. Funds in the amount of \$144,000.00 are available from 1987 General Obligation Drainage Improvement Bonds, \$362,000.00 from 1999 General Obligation Street Improvement Bonds, \$67,000.00 from 2001 Certificates of Obligation, \$61,308.84 from 2002 Certificates of Obligation, and \$160,573.50 from San Antonio Water System (SAWS) for sewer and water work, for an overall total of \$794,882.34 to be authorized payable as follows:

\$737,217.90	payable to R.L. Jones, LP. for construction expenses
\$ 57,664.44	payable for miscellaneous construction contingency

COORDINATION

This request for ordinance has been coordinated with the Office of Management and Budget and the Finance Department.

SUPPLEMENTARY COMMENTS

This construction contract was developed utilizing the formal competitive bid process; therefore, a Discretionary Contracts Disclosure Form is not required.


