SUBJECT: Ordinance accepting and authorizing the execution of a Joint Use Agreement in connection with an existing Drainage and Sanitary Sewer Right of Way

SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

This ordinance accepts and authorizes a Joint Use Agreement between the City of San Antonio and the San Antonio Water System (SAWS) and authorizes the City Manager or her designee to execute same in connection with an existing Drainage and Sanitary Sewer Right of Way for the West Salado Creek – Lift Station Elimination Phase II project located in Council District 3.

Staff recommends the approval of this ordinance.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The San Antonio Water System is requesting permission to use a 0.26 acre tract of land (11,168 square feet) of City property out of a Drainage and Sanitary Sewer Right of Way for construction of SAWS project known as West Salado Creek – Lift Station Elimination Phase II. The length of the right of way property is located along Arrid Drive, Smallwood Drive, and Hicks Avenue. The scope of the project includes the installation of an additional sewer line in conjunction with the existing provided services in the area.

POLICY ANALYSIS

The San Antonio Water System is a municipally owned utility of the City of San Antonio and joint use of the property would benefit SAWS and the City.

FISCAL IMPACT


No funds are to be expended in this ordinance.


COORDINATION
