SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

This ordinance accepts the low qualified responsive bid and awards a construction contract in the amount of \$434,376.95 payable to E-Z Bel Construction, LTD., a MBE firm, and authorizes \$39,539.20 for construction contingency expenses, and \$27,677.44 for expense recovery, for an overall total of \$501,593.59 in connection with the Fleming – Gerald to New Laredo Hwy., and Gerald – Fleming to New Laredo Hwy., and Lovett – Oregon to Fleming, authorized Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) projects, located in Council District 4. Of the \$501,593.59, \$462,608.59 will be funded from CDBG funds and \$38,985.00 will be funded by San Antonio Water System (SAWS) for sewer and water work.

Staff recommends approval of this ordinance.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The Fleming – Gerald to New Laredo Hwy. project provides for reconstruction of 330 feet of Fleming from New Laredo Hwy. to Gerald to a 30–foot two lane street section with sidewalks, curbs, driveway approaches, and underground drainage. The Gerald – Fleming to New Laredo Hwy. project provides for reconstruction of Gerald from Fleming to Gifford to a 30-foot two lane street section and Gerald from Gifford to New Laredo Hwy. to a 26-foot two-lane street section including four-foot sidewalks, curbs, and driveway approaches. The Lovett – Oregon to Fleming project provides for reconstruction of 620 feet of Lovett Street from Fleming to Oregon to a 30-foot two-lane street section with sidewalks, curbs, driveway approaches, and underground drainage. This project is scheduled to begin construction July 2003, and be completed by December 2003.

This project was advertised for construction bids in the Commercial Recorder, the San Antonio Informer, and La Prensa in April 2003. In addition, the bid announcement was made on TVSA, through the SBEDA office and Dodge Report. Plans were also available for review by potential bidders in the Public Works Office.

Bids for this project were opened on May 14, 2003 with five (5) bidders responding. A matrix reflecting the outcome of the bid process is attached.

The Economic Development Department has reviewed and approved the List of Subcontractors and the Good Faith Effort Plan submitted by E-Z Bel Construction, Ltd. The contractor is a certified MBE firm and will construct \$415,697.00 (95.7%) of the contract, with an additional \$1,200.00 (.27%) to WBE firms. The contract provides for 85 working days or approximately five (5) months to complete the project. E-Z Bel Construction, Ltd. currently has five (5) construction contracts with the City of San Antonio in the total amount of \$25,833,281.00. A list of these projects is attached.

POLICY ANALYSIS

Approval of this ordinance will be a continuation of City Council policy to complete previously approved Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funded Capital Improvement Projects.

FISCAL IMPACT

This is a one-time capital improvement expenditure within budget and included in the FY 03-08 Capital Improvement Program Budget. Funds in the amount of \$462,608.59 are available from Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and \$38,985.00 will be funded from SAWS for sewer and water work, for an overall total of \$501,593.59 to be authorized payable as follows:

\$ 39,539.20	payable for miscellaneous construction contingency			
\$ 27,677.44	payable for expense recovery			

This item represents a portion of the total estimated City project cost of \$577,660.00.

COORDINATION

This request for ordinance has been coordinated with the Office of Management and Budget, the Finance Department, and the Housing and Community Development Department.

SUPPLEMENTARY COMMENTS

This construction contract was developed utilizing the formal competitive bid process; therefore, a Discretionary Contracts Disclosure Form is not required.


