SUBJECT: ORDINANCE APPROVING THE APPOINTMENT OF SAMMY G. NIETO TO THE ALAMO WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT BOARD

DATE: June 26, 2003

SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

This Ordinance approves the appointment of Sammy G. Nieto to the Alamo Workforce Development Board (AWDB) to fill a vacancy as a result of a resignation by a representative in the category of private sector large/for profit business. Representatives from the Committee of Six; Councilman Enrique Barrera, Bexar County Commissioners Adkisson and Elizondo, Commissioner Millikin of Comal County, and Judge Evans of Bandera County met on June 6, 2003 to interview and recommend an applicant to this board. The Committee selected Mr. Nieto from a pool of six nominees to serve an unexpired three-year term on the Alamo Workforce Development Board (AWDB).

Staff recommends approval of this ordinance.

BACKGROUND

Vacancies on the Alamo Workforce Development Board (AWDB) are filled by the Chief Elected Officials (CEO's) of the Alamo region through their representatives on the Committee of Six. The Committee of Six received six nominations for the category of private sector large/for profit business vacancy, interviewed one individual, and considered five previously interviewed candidates. The Rural Area Judges, and Bexar County Commissioners Court as well as the San Antonio City Council must approve this appointment.

This ordinance is a continuation of current City policy authorizing the City Council to review and approve appointments to the AWDB through the Interlocal Agreement between the Chief Elected Officials and the Alamo Workforce Development Inc.

FISCAL IMPACT


There is no direct fiscal implication from the approval of this nomination.
