SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

This ordinance authorizes the City Manager or her designated representative to accept a donation in the amount of \$2,000.00 from Wal-Mart to the Fire Department's Community Resources and Education Program.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

As a community relations initiative, Wal-Mart has indicated a desire to donate \$2,000 to the City of San Antonio Fire Department. These funds will be utilized to support Fire Department Public Education Programs. The programs range from the Adopt a School Program to Fire Prevention Week activities. Donations such as these make it possible to provide much needed safety education throughout our community.


