#### SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

This ordinance accepts the low qualified responsive bid and awards a construction contract in the amount of \$1,871,936.19 payable to E-Z Bel Construction, Ltd., a MBE firm, authorizes \$144,909.30 for construction contingency expenses, \$101,436.51 for expense recovery, and adds \$5,000 to the design contingency for an overall total of \$2,123,282.00 in connection with the Waverly from Bandera to Glenmore, Phase I & II project, located in Council District 7. Of the \$2,123,282.00 total amount, \$1,700,438.85 will be funded from Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds, \$326,703.15 will be funded by San Antonio Water System (SAWS), and \$96,140.00 will be funded by City Public Service (CPS).

Staff recommends approval of this ordinance.

#### **BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

This project includes the reconstruction of Rollins from Leo to Bandera and Waverly from Bandera to Glenmore, and the reconstruction of the concrete open drainage in the easement that connects Texas and Waverly Streets. The project will also include parkway improvements such as new curbs, sidewalks and driveway approaches along with the necessary storm, sewer and utility improvements. This project is scheduled to begin construction in October 2003 and to be completed by October 2004.

This Project was advertised for construction bids in the Commercial Recorder, the San Antonio Informer, and La Prensa in July 2003. In addition, the bid announcement was made on TVSA, through the SBEDA Office and Dodge Report. Plans were also available for review by potential bidders in the Public Works Office.

Bids for the Project were opened on August 27, 2003 with three (3) bidders responding. A matrix reflecting the outcome of the bid process is attached.

The Economic Development Department has reviewed and approved the List of Subcontractors and the Good Faith Effort Plan submitted by E-Z Bel Construction, Ltd. The contractor has committed to subcontract \$1,679,536.19 (89.721%) to MBE firms and \$92,000 (4.914%) to WBE firms. The contract provides for 310 calendar days, or approximately 10 months, to complete the project. E-Z Bel Construction, Ltd. currently has seven (7) construction contracts with the City of San Antonio through the Public Works Department in the total amount of \$26,673,692. A list of projects is attached.

#### **POLICY ANALYSIS**

Approval of this ordinance will be a continuation of City Council policy to complete previously approved Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funded Capital Improvement Projects.

#### FISCAL IMPACT

This is a one-time capital improvement expenditure within budget and included in the FY04-09 Capital Improvement Program Budget. Funds in the amount of \$1,700,438.85 are available from Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds, \$326,703.15 are available from San Antonio Water System (SAWS) and \$96,140.00 are available from City Public Service (CPS) and are authorized payable as follows:

#### **COORDINATION**


