SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

This ordinance accepts the low qualified responsive bid and awards a construction contract in the amount of \$1,071,279.90 payable to R.L. Jones, L.P., a non-MBE firm, authorizes \$66,080.92 for construction contingency expenses, \$46,265.65 for expense recovery, for an overall total of \$1,183,626.47 in connection with the Culebra Area Streets, Phase III project, located in Council District 7. Of the \$1,183,626.47 total amount, \$773,155.72 will be funded from Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds, \$332,355.00 will be funded by San Antonio Water System (SAWS), and \$78,115.75 will be funded by City Public Service (CPS).

Staff recommends approval of this ordinance.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

This project includes the reconstruction of Brandy Wine, Lark, Continental and Globe from Roanoke to Maiden and Maiden from Culebra to Bangor to a thirty-foot (30') width. The project will also include parkway improvements such as new curbs, sidewalks and driveway approaches along with the necessary storm, sewer and utility improvements. This project is scheduled to begin construction in October 2003 and to be completed by December 2004.

This Project was advertised for construction bids in the Commercial Recorder, the San Antonio Informer, and La Prensa in July 2003. In addition, the bid announcement was made on TVSA, through the SBEDA Office and Dodge Report. Plans were also available for review by potential bidders in the Public Works Office.

Bids for the Project were opened on September 10, 2003 with five (5) bidders responding. A matrix reflecting the outcome of the bid process is attached.

The Economic Development Department has reviewed and approved the List of Subcontractors and the Good Faith Effort Plan submitted by R.L. Jones, L.P. The contractor has committed to subcontract \$255,500 (23.8499%) to MBE firms and \$78,000 (7.281%) to WBE firms. The contract provides for 250 calendar days, or approximately 9 months, to complete the project. R.L. Jones, L.P. currently has four (4) construction contracts with the City of San Antonio through the Public Works Department in the total amount of \$5,904,819.00. A list of projects is attached.

POLICY ANALYSIS

Approval of this ordinance will be a continuation of City Council policy to complete previously approved Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funded Capital Improvement Projects.

FISCAL IMPACT

This is a one-time capital improvement expenditure within budget and included in the FY04-09 Capital Improvement Program Budget. Funds in the amount of \$773,155.72 are available from Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds, \$332,355.00 are available from San Antonio Water System (SAWS) and \$78,115.75 are available from City Public Service (CPS) and are authorized payable as follows:

COORDINATION




