SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

This ordinance appoints the Chairs of the Citizens Commission on City/County Service Integration and the Joint City-County Citizens Bond Oversight Commission.

Staff recommends approval of this ordinance.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

On September 11, 2003, the City Council approved an ordinance to create the Joint City-County Citizens Bond Oversight Commission, and on September 25, 2003, the City Council approved an ordinance to create the Citizens Commission on City/County Service Integration. Those ordinances stipulate that the Chairs of these Commissions will be selected jointly by the Mayor of San Antonio and the County Judge. This ordinance appoints Terrell McCombs to serve as Chair of the Joint City-County Citizens Bond Oversight Commission and Glen Hartman to serve as Chair of the Citizens Commission on City/County Service Integration.

POLICY ANALYSIS

Approval of this ordinance is consistent with the City's policy to collaborate with Bexar County on new initiatives to increase the level of communication and coordination and integrate service delivery to citizens as a means of enhancing the quality and effectiveness of existing services at a reduced cost to the taxpayer.

FISCAL IMPACT

There is no financial impact associated with this ordinance.

This ordinance has been coordinated with the Office of the Mayor, the City Attorney's Office, the Office of External Affairs, and Bexar County.
