SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

This ordinance accepts a Permanent Drainage Easement Dedication from the Tom Slick Memorial Trust for Southwest Research Institute and the Southwest Research Institute, in connection with the Culebra/Loop 410 (Leon Creek) Regional Storm Water Detention Facilities Project, a 1999 General Obligation Flood Control with Park Improvement Bond project, located in Council District 6.

Staff recommends the approval of this ordinance.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Southwest Research Institute is dedicating a 207.513 acre tract of land as a Permanent Drainage Easement for the Culebra/Loop 410 Detention Facility Project which will serve as a regional storm water facility to reduce peak discharges downstream of Loop 410. The "Facility" constitutes a series of berms, concrete walls, culverts, and swales used to contain stormwater flows in the Leon Creek. The facility was proposed in the Leon Creek Watershed Master Drainage Plan prepared by Pape-Dawson Engineers in November 1996. The facility is located approximately at the intersection of Culebra Road and I.H. 410 on Southwest Research Institute property. The project is currently under construction and is scheduled for completion in July 2004.

POLICY ANALYSIS

The acceptance of the Permanent Drainage Easement Dedication is in the best interest of the public and the proposed location is the most appropriate.

FISCAL IMPACT

No funds are to be expended in this ordinance.

COORDINATION

This ordinance was coordinated with the City Attorney's Office, the Storm Water Engineering Division of Public Works, and the Southwest Research Institute.
