SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS:

This ordinance will approve the parade permit and authorize the temporary closure of certain streets in connection with the Sights, Taste, & Sounds of the Awesome Austin Hwy being held on Saturday, September 27, 2003. The run/walk will assemble at Uptown Café (1271 Austin Hwy) and disband at Terrell Plaza. The route is attached.

COORDINATION:



FINANCIAL IMPACT:


