#### **SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS**

This ordinance authorizes Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds in the amount of \$144,000, payable to Lawyers Title of San Antonio as escrow agent for Meadowlawn Memorial Park, Inc. for the acquisition of one Permanent Drainage Easement (\$142,500), and Title Fees (\$1,500), in connection with the Eastgate Drainage Improvements project, a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) authorized project, located in Council District 2.

Staff recommends approval of this ordinance.

#### **BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

There is one parcel to acquire in this one-parcel project. The scope of this project provides for the purchase of right of way (permanent drainage easement) for future drainage improvements in the Eastgate Subdivision.

#### **POLICY ANALYSIS**

The acquisition of this property is necessary to complete the real estate transaction in this project.

#### FISCAL IMPACT

This is a one-time capital improvement expenditure within budget and is included in the FY03-FY08 Capital Improvement Program Budget. Funds in the amount of \$144,000 are available from Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds and authorized payable to Lawyers Title of San Antonio. This item represents a portion of a total estimated City project cost of \$144,000.
