SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

This Ordinance will declare as surplus to City of San Antonio's needs a 0.276 acre tract of land owned and controlled by the Texas Department of Transportation for disposition to Mr. R. J. Keller, the abutting property owner.

Staff recommends approval of this Ordinance.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Petitioner is requesting the City of San Antonio declare as surplus to our needs a 0.276 acre tract of land located at the northeast corner of S.E. Military Drive (Loop 13) and South Presa Street (Old U.S. 181), adjacent to the remaining portion of Lot 8, NCB 10930, as shown on attached Exhibits "A" & "B". This property is currently owned and controlled by the Texas Department of Transportation. Prior to declaring any property surplus, the Texas Department of Transportation allows the City of San Antonio the right of first refusal over any properties it is considering for disposition. The City has determined that there is no need for this property.

POLICY ANALYSIS

The action being taken is consistent with Texas Department of Transportation policy to cooperate with municipalities and other jurisdiction responsible for public transportation needs

FISCAL IMPACT

Their will be no financial impact as the City does not own or control this property.

COORDINATION

In compliance with City procedures, this request has been canvassed through interested City departments, public utilities and applicable agencies. A Canvassing Checklist is attached for review.





FIELD NOTE DESCRIPTION FOR TRACT__1__

Description of a 0.276 of an acre tract of land (12045 square feet) located in the City of San Antonio, Bexar County, Texas out of the Wm. Small Survey No. 26, Abstract No. 670 being a portion of Loop 13 as shown on right-of-way map of Loop 13, being part of that same tract conveyed from the Texas Synod, Evangelical and Reformed Church to the State of Texas and recorded in Volume 1877, Page 290-291 of the Deed Records of Bexar County, Texas.

Beginning at a ½" iron pin found in the north right-of-way line of Loop 13 at its cut-off to the east line of Old Highway U. S. 181 (South Presa St.) for the southeast corner of this tract and being the southwest corner of Lot 8 of Big Town Subdivision as recorded in Volume 4400, Page 221 of the Plat Records of Bexar County, Texas, being S 85° 14' 00" W. 35.06 feet from a ½" iron pin found at the southwest corner of Lot 17 of Big Town Subdivision as recorded in Volume 9539, Page 79 of the Plat Records of Bexar County, Texas and being 82.93 feet left of centerline Station 317+29.79.

- 1) Thence with said north right-of-way line of Loop 13, S 85° 14' 00" W. 55.00 feet to a ½" iron pin with yellow cap stamped "Baker Surveying" set for the southwest corner of this tract, being 87.58 feet left of centerline Station 316+74.99.
- 2) Thence across a cut-off N 65° 28' 48" W. 202.84 feet to a ½" iron pin with yellow plastic cap stamped "Baker Surveying" set in the old east right-of-way line of South Presa Street, being 60.00 feet right of and radial to centerline station 129+81.20.

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- 3) Thence with the old east right-of-way line of South Presa Street and the arc of a curve to the right, a total arc distance of 12.87 feet, through a central angle of 00° 05' 11", having a radius of 8534.41 feet and a chord that bears N 27° 38' 07" W. a distance of 12.87 feet to an iron pin with yellow plastic cap stamped "Baker Surveying" set for a corner and being a corner of a remainder of a tract conveyed to Bexar County and recorded by Deed in Volume 1578, Page 253 of the Deed Records of Bexar County, Texas, being 60.00 feet right of and radial to centerline station 129+94.09.
- 4) Thence with a southeast line of said Bexar County tract N 22° 40' 00" E. 62.64 feet to an iron pin with yellow plastic cap stamped "Baker Surveying" set at its intersection with the northeast right-of-way line of the cut-off between Loop 13 and South Presa Street (Old U. S. 181).
- 5) Thence with said cut-off line S 56° 04' 00" E. 266.60 feet to the point of beginning and containing 0.276 of an acre (12045 square feet) of land.

All bearings are based on the northerly right-of-way line of Loop 13.

Enclosed is a resolution with accompanying survey plat and field notes prepared on the above referenced location. R.J. Keller, property owner, would like to purchase the adjoining property from the State.

R.J. Keller is requesting that the State declare a 0.276 of an acre of land, more or less, surplus to our transportation needs. However, before we declare it surplus to our needs, the department must make a thorough study before recommending that the property be declared surplus. The study is done in close cooperation with the City and others responsible for public transportation needs. In some cases, the city and/or county that has jurisdiction may determine that a need still exists at the local level and they are therefore willing to assume jurisdiction and responsibility of the property. If the property is not needed at the local jurisdiction, it has been the policy of the Department to request that the local jurisdiction provide a formal action stating the property is surplus to their needs. A resolution/ordinance from the city council will satisfy our requirement that the right of way is no longer needed for use by citizens as a road, or any other related roadway purposes.

Therefore, the enclosed resolution is a type of canvassing on our part to make sure that the city and/or county does not need the right of way for use by citizens as road or any other highway purposes. Please review the resolution. If you concur, please submit it to the San Antonio City Council for their approval and execution. When we receive the fully executed resolution, we will make our recommendation to the Transportation Commission in Austin.
