SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

This Ordinance authorizes the City Manager to accept a grant in the amount of \$239,342.00 from the Texas State Library and Archives Commission. This Ordinance also authorizes the City Manager to appropriate funds and to authorize a personnel complement for this grant. Funds will be used for operation of the San Antonio Interlibrary Loan Center. San Antonio Public Library is the designated Major Resource Center of 21 contiguous counties, including Bexar County. The City of San Antonio has received annual grants under this program since 1972. Benefit to the Bexar County area library patrons is a centralized Interlibrary Loan service with access to libraries across the United States. Council authorization to apply for this grant was received on June 12, 2003 by Ordinance # 97753.

Staff recommends approval of this ordinance.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

This grant will be for state fiscal year 2004, beginning September 1, 2003 and ending August 31, 2004. Funds from this grant will be used to provide Interlibrary Loan services and consulting to public, special, and academic libraries in the Alamo Area Library System service area, comprised of 21 counties including Bexar County. The San Antonio Public Library serves as the Major Resource Center of this area and, in this capacity, is eligible for this grant.

POLICY ANALYSIS

This action is consistent with City Council direction to accept State/Federal Grant Funds to enhance services for local residents. Benefit to Bexar County residents is a centralized Interlibrary Loan service with access to libraries across the United States.

FISCAL IMPACT

This grant, totaling \$239,342.00, provides one hundred percent of personnel, fringe benefits, and operating costs associated with the grant. Indirect costs have been provided for and will be paid to the City for administration of the grant, as per the City's Indirect Cost Plan.

COORDINATION

This item has been coordinated with the Finance Department, Office of Management and Budget, and the Human Resources Department. Staff of these Departments concur with this recommendation.

SUPPLEMENTARY COMMENTS
