SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

This ordinance selects K. M. Ng and Associates, Inc. for professional electrical engineering services associated with the Westside YMCA HVAC Replacement Project in City Council District 5; authorizes a professional services contract in an amount not to exceed \$26.596.64; establishes a project budget; allocates \$33,896.00 from Facility Improvement Maintenance Program (FIMP) funds and provides \$2,700.00 for consultant contingency, \$3,500.00 for an asbestos survey and \$1,099.36 for bid advertising/printing.

Staff recommends approval of this ordinance.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The Westside YMCA is located at 2900 Ruiz Street in Council District 5. It is a City-owned facility that is leased to the YMCA. The building requires replacement of the existing heating/ventilation/air-conditioning unit, which has been repaired numerous times over the past few years. This ordinance will hire a consultant electrical engineering firm that will develop specifications to demolish most components of the existing HVAC system and install a new chiller, boiler, circulation pump and system controls. Specifications will also be developed to rehabilitate the existing air handlers, electrical systems, coils and piping. The consultant will prepare a schematic design, cost estimates and construction documents and will perform construction administration services. Concurrently, an asbestos survey will be performed, as directed by code requirements.

The firm of K. M. Ng and Associates, Inc., a SMBE firm, has been selected to provide the Westside YMCA HVAC Replacement Project design work. The design is scheduled to begin in October 2003 and to be completed in December 2003. Following bid and contract award procedures, construction is anticipated to occur from March 2004 until May 2004.

POLICY ANALYSIS

The consultant was selected in accordance with established selection procedures. The use of available Facility Improvement Maintenance Program funds for this project is an acceptable use of the funds.

FISCAL IMPACT

Funding of \$213,866.00 from FIMP and CDBG funds has been identified for the Westside YMCA HVAC Replacement Project. At this time, the amount of \$33,896.00 will be allocated for this consultant project from FY01 FIMP funds. Consultant fees are \$26,596.64, consultant contingency is \$2,700.00, asbestos survey is \$3,500.00 and bid advertising/printing is \$1,099.36.

COORDINATION

The Consultant Selection Committee, Public Works Department, Housing and Community Development Department, Finance Department and Office of Management and Budget have assisted with this action.

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
